■ Objectives

The MIT-Zaragoza International Logistics Program is a unique research and education partnership that brings together the supply chain interests of academia, industry and government – all linked to the development of the largest and most up-to-date logistics park in Europe.

Combining general management know-how with specialist logistics and supply chain management skills, this dual degree program in cooperation with the renowned MIT-Zaragoza is designed to prepare graduates for international managerial positions.

■ Deadlines

Zaragoza Logistics Center MIT-Zaragoza Program: Three rounds in November, February and April, though applications must be submitted no later than April.

EBS Business School (EBS): Rolling admissions, though applications must be submitted no later than June.

■ Admissions Criteria

Students are required to apply to both schools separately. They will be evaluated for admission by each school based on its respective requirements and criteria. Certain application material can be shared by both institutions during the admission process.

Students wishing to receive confirmation of acceptance to both programs before making a final decision should submit both applications by the deadline of the program they first wish to enter. Please check the admission website of each program to verify the respective deadlines and other requirements.

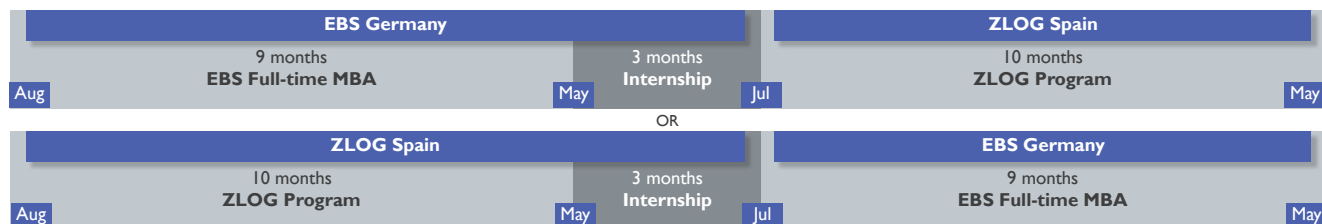
■ Dual Degree Structure

In only 22 months you can earn the following degrees:

- Master of Engineering in Logistics and Supply Chain Management (ZLOG). MIT-Zaragoza Program at ZLC (University of Zaragoza) in Spain
- EBS Full-time MBA. EBS Business School in Germany

You can start the program at the institution of your choice. For acceptance to the respective degree program, you must satisfy the requirements of each school. To obtain the ZLOG degree, students are required to earn a minimum of 60 ZLC course units (equivalent to ECTS credits) awarded for core and elective courses. To gain the MBA degree, you have to successfully complete the first and second term of the EBS Full-time MBA. Selected courses in the ZLOG program will additionally count towards the completion of the MBA degree.

To obtain both degrees, students are required to submit a joint Master's thesis combining both programs. Each academic year starts in August and ends in May.



■ Fees and Financial aid

ZLOG Programme: 24,000 € plus 300 € administration fee.

EBS Full-timeMBA: 23,500 € plus 100 € admissions fee.

The regular three-term EBS Full-time MBA costs 32,500 €.

Request for financial support will be processed separately by each institution and in accordance with the school's policy.
