OBJECTIVES

The spectacular rise of global commerce continues to play out with ever-increasing, great opportunities and challenges. Extensive re-education in the areas of logistics and global supply chain management is required to succeed within the new world economy. This double degree program helps students bring out their best by nurturing innovation and entrepreneurship, together with a solid foundation of business knowledge and quantitative methodologies. It also prepares the most capable students for global leadership in these fields. Moreover, this program familiarizes students with major transportation and logistics issues as well as equips students with holistic thinking and disruptive innovation to cope with these issues in order to gain a competitive edge in global operations.

This dual degree program is intended to prepare professionals for careers that combine entrepreneurial capabilities with specialized logistics and supply chain management skills.

DUAL DEGREE STRUCTURE

In just 22 months you can obtain the following degrees:

- **MIT Zaragoza Master of Engineering in Logistics and Supply Chain Management (ZLOG)** at the Zaragoza Logistics Center (ZLC) in Zaragoza, Spain.
- **Master of Management Science with the Emphasis in Transportation and Logistics (MMS)** at Feng Chia University in Taiwan.

The first academic year of the program is conducted at Feng Chia University, TAIWAN, including a study tour and field study on transportation and logistics in Asia. This is followed by a 2-month internship, which can be taken anywhere in the world from both schools, to find the most suitable placement and work assignment. The second academic year is at Zaragoza Logistics Center, SPAIN, including 3 weeks at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), USA.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Students apply to both schools separately and are evaluated for admission by each, based on respective requirements and criteria, including GMAT or GRE. For administrative identification, applicants for the dual degree program are requested to indicate their intentions on their application to both schools, facilitating close consultation between both institutions' admission offices. Please note that tuition scholarships supporting the dual degree program are only available if application and admission to both schools have been processed prior to commencement of either.
